Based on independent re-audit findings, the website bharatstockmarketresearch.com conforms to WCAG 2.1 Level AA as of 20 May 2026. All Level A and Level AA non-conformances identified in the original audit (09 May 2026) have been verified as successfully remediated.

3. Evaluation Methodology

This re-audit was conducted in accordance with the W3C Website Accessibility Conformance Evaluation Methodology (WCAG-EM), comprising automated scanning (axe DevTools, WAVE, Lighthouse), manual keyboard-only navigation, screen reader testing (NVDA 2024.1 with Chrome; VoiceOver on iOS), and structural review (HeadingsMap, W3C Nu HTML Validator, WebAIM Contrast Checker, Chrome DevTools). Each of the 15 non-conformances identified in the original audit (ACR-092, 09 May 2026) was individually re-tested and verified as remediated. No new issues were introduced as a result of remediation changes.

4. Important Notice

- This certificate is valid as of the re-audit date of 20 May 2026. Future content updates, design changes, plugin upgrades, or technical modifications may introduce new accessibility issues and should be subject to re-evaluation. This certificate does not provide prospective or ongoing conformance assurance.
- This certificate does not constitute a legal certification of compliance and is not an endorsement by the W3C, IAAP, or any regulatory authority.
